## International Make Meeting

### 25.-28. May 2017 in Sigmaringen



#### *Dear ZÜNDAPP friends,*

All over the world you care for the various vehicles out of the large ZÜNDAPP stables and by doing so, you contribute to keeping the make alive. Frequently, ZÜNDAPP clubs, networks, internet pages, forums etc. focus on a particular ZÜNDAPP vehicle type or model. While these clubs contact each other, one thing has never happened: a grand international meeting where all models are displayed and ZÜNDAPP enthusiasts from all over the world come together.

In 1917 the 'Zünder- und Apparatebau GmbH' was founded, the seed of what would later become 'ZÜNDAPP Werke GmbH'. What could be a better occasion than the 100-year anniversary to bring ZÜNDAPP friends from all over the globe together in a unique event. For exactly this reason many ZÜNDAPP clubs, collectors and enthusiasts, together with Brewery 'Zoller-Hof', have been preparing a meeting, the likes of which has never been seen and is not likely to happen again anytime soon.

You are invited to the 100 year ZÜNDAPP event in Sigmaringen, Germany, from the 25th to the 28th of May 2017 where you can spend a whole weekend with ZÜNDAPP lovers from around the world and share your passion in a relaxed environment.

An extensive agenda awaits you:

- **Thursday May 25<sup>th</sup>**, is planned as the day of arrival. Besides getting to know each other, you can partake in a small drive in the Sigmaringen country side and visit the ZÜNDAPP museum. You will find parts on offer on the meeting grounds on the day, as well as during the rest of the event and you can watch historical ZÜNDAPP footage. The official opening will take place in the evening in the party tent.
- **Friday the 26<sup>th</sup>** is intended as a day to enjoy where you can visit various points of interest in the surroundings. In Sigmaringen castle you can discover the history of the Hohenzollern family. The day will end with a party in the tent on the grounds where you can enjoy yourself and have ZÜNDAPP conversations.
- **Saturday the 27<sup>th</sup> of May** is the day of the show. This will take place on the meeting grounds and guests and onlookers are more than welcome. This will include a very unique display of the make through the years and will include vehicles of participants on display. This will provide a one-time only overview of many ZÜNDAPP models and their evolution through the years. Not only will the show include factory models, but also special builds, joint ventures, vehicles built under licence and aftermarket builds. Those who visit the show will be asked to vote for the most beautiful machines of each

model in a 'concours d'élégance'. In addition, you can demonstrate your mastery of your ZÜNDAPP in a skills contest and 'slow race'. There will also be a test bench to measure the power out of your ZÜNDAPP. The event will end with a combined ride out with all models and a party with prizes for the winners of the concours on the grounds.

- **On Sunday the 28<sup>th</sup>** you can say goodbye to your new friends and acquaintances.

*(Of course you can arrive before the 25<sup>th</sup> or depart after the 28<sup>th</sup> if you make your own arrangements for those days.)*

We are pleased to present you the agenda of this meeting which, in line with the occasion, is a class apart from other ZÜNDAPP events. A fee is payable for the event which includes a show magazine, entry to the ZÜNDAPP museum and an anniversary pin for the event.

To ensure that the meeting will run smoothly and without incident, house rules will be in effect which you can read below. Visitors are welcome and can gain entry by purchasing a ticket for the meeting. However, they will have to park their non-ZÜNDAPP vehicles outside the meeting grounds by the tower. The event is intended to be specific for the ZÜNDAPP make and only ZÜNDAPP vehicles or those built under licence with a ZÜNDAPP engine can partake in the event.

It is good to know that when the event was announced, many known parties have declared themselves willing to sponsor the event, either financially or with content which will contribute to the experience. Noteworthy is that former ZÜNDAPP factory employees and racers have immediately confirmed their participation in the event.

As a result, a once in ZÜNDAPP lifetime event awaits you where you and your ZÜNDAPP should not miss out.

We are looking forward to your participation and the sooner you register, the easier it will be to organise the event.

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#### 1. The event

ZÜNDAPP 100 is a ZÜNDAPP make event for ZÜNDAPP owners and enthusiasts that will be held from May 25<sup>th</sup> till May 28<sup>th</sup> 2017 to celebrate the 100-year anniversary of the make.

#### 2. Event location

The event will take place on the festive grounds in Sigmaringen. The address is Georg-Zimmerer-Straße, 72488 Sigmaringen.

#### 3. Organiser

#### 4. Sponsors, premium and media partners

The organiser will be supported during the preparation for and running of the event by many clubs, interest groups, internet forums, museums and enthusiasts who are dedicated to the maintenance, preservation and presentation of ZÜNDAPP products. Support will also be provided by other organisations, corporations, companies and media.

#### 5. Participants and vehicles

Participants are defined as drivers, passengers and supporting parties. They are permitted to participate with ZÜNDAPP vehicles and other vehicles powered by a ZÜNDAPP engine. This includes vehicles produced under license and reproductions.

Participants confirm that:

- Information provided in the entry form is complete and accurate
- They are willing and able to meet the requirements of the event without reservation
- Their vehicles comply with all technical requirements of vehicles driven on public roads. In German: StVZO requirements
- Any vehicles used in the event are technically sound
- Participants will comply with instructions given by the organiser, those working with or for the organiser and local authorities.

The exact schedule will be published on the event web-site ([www.zuendapp100.org](http://www.zuendapp100.org)). The organiser reserves the right to change the agenda as required and participants do not have the option of requesting specific activities that change the agenda during the event.

#### 7. Entry and entry Fee

The entry fee is dependent on the date when participants confirm their attendance and is payable for any participants age 15 or over.

- a) 28,00 EUR per participant up to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016
- b) 30,00 EUR per participant between 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017 and 15<sup>th</sup> March 2017
- c) 34,00 EUR per participant from the 16<sup>th</sup> March 2017
- d) 11,00 EUR per participant for a day ticket on the 25<sup>th</sup> May and 26<sup>th</sup> May 2017 (only obtainable at the on-the-day cash register)
- e) 16,00 EUR per participant for a day ticket on the 27<sup>th</sup> May 2017 (only at the on-the-day cash register)

Participants are defined as drivers, passengers or other supporting parties. Entry for children up to and including 14 years of age, is free.

School-going children older than 14, students and the severely handicapped obtain a discount of 3,00 EUR for price categories a through c and 1,50 EUR for categories d and e.

Included in the entry fee is the following:

- Access to the event grounds including the party tent
- Participation in the activities on the agenda in so far as practically possible
- One-time entry to the ZÜNDAPP museum in Sigmaringen (this is not included in price category d)

In addition, included for price categories a) through c) is:

- Event magazine
- Event anniversary lapel pin
- One-time entry into the museum of the 'friends of the old-timers' Messkirch e.v. on May 26<sup>th</sup> 2017
- Special entry fee for a viewing of Sigmaringen castle on the 26<sup>th</sup> May 2017 including a right of entry for a ZÜNDAPP vehicle to castle parking.

Submitting a completed and signed entry form, including the liability waiver for the organisers and recognition of other event rules, as well as the payment of the nominal fees, is a precondition for participation in the event. The entry fee will not be refunded for cancellations or the inability to attend the event.

The number of participants is limited; the organiser can decline an entry form at their discretion. Should an entry from be declined, the entry fee will be refunded.

#### 8. Visitor tickets

Day visitors are welcome and they can enter the event grounds, also without a vehicle, after buying a ticket on the day from the on-site cash register (price advertised on the day).

#### 9. Accommodation

Participants need to arrange their own accommodation. Sample accommodation can be found on the event website ([www.zuendapp100.org](http://www.zuendapp100.org)).

There is some, but limited, possibility of staying the night on the event grounds.

To book tent or camping places, please indicate this on the entry form and separately fill out the additional camping form. Camping places are not guaranteed, but rather given out in date order of incoming entry forms. You will receive confirmation if you request a camping place on its availability.

#### 10. Vehicles on the event grounds

Entry onto and driving on the event grounds is reserved for event participants. Reference is made to article 5. in this document. Using vehicles on the grounds should be kept to a minimum and vehicles should not be used to drive around event grounds as a means of viewing the events or getting around on the event grounds. Normal traffic rules and regulations apply on the event grounds (StVO). Any vehicle use should not exceed walking pace on the event grounds. A security service for the vehicles on the event grounds will not be provided.

Transport, tractor and trailer vehicles should be parked in the spaces available outside the event grounds. Permission for a short period of entry onto the grounds to load and unload can be granted by the organiser.

#### 11. Motorcycle trips

Suggestions for trips by motorcycle can be found in the event magazine. Some interesting waypoints will be included. The motorcycle routes are purely touristic in nature and participation is optional. Target times for the tours are not available or required; they are at your discretion. The proposed routes are optional and event participants can select their own route should they wish. Participants are responsible for coordinating the tours themselves and do not need to specify departure or arrival times. Normal traffic rules apply for the tours which is especially relevant for those who wish to ride in a group.

A stamp can be collected at way points on a route card. The card is a ticket for an event prize lottery.

#### 12. Skills competition

Participants can partake in a parkour with various riding challenges on the event grounds. This is not aimed at attaining the fastest completion time, but rather at obtaining fewest penalty points at a low speed. All participants are required to wear suitable safety equipment and helmets are mandatory.

Scores will be assessed across the various displacement classes and vehicle types. If scores are equal, the slowest time in the race will win. Due to time constraints, participation in activities cannot be guaranteed. Three and four wheeled vehicles cannot participate in this activity.

#### 13. Slow race

On the event grounds participants can ride in a pre-defined course. In this activity the aim is to achieve as slow a time as possible. The winning time will be the slowest time without touching the ground while completing the course.

All participants are required to wear suitable safety equipment and helmets are mandatory.

Scores will be assessed across the various displacement classes and vehicle types. Due to time constraints, participation in the event cannot be guaranteed. Three and four wheeled vehicles cannot participate in this event.

#### 14. Motorcycle dyno Test

Participants have the opportunity to submit their vehicles to a test on a Dyno power measuring stand at their own risk. Using the test, it is possible to improve engine timing and settings. This can have a positive effect on fuel economy and engine emissions as well as performance. Participation in this activity cannot be guaranteed due to time restrictions.

#### 15. Display of movies

ZÜNDAPP movies from various decades will be shown in a movie tent on the event grounds. Participation in this activity cannot be guaranteed due time and seating restrictions. It is not allowed to record any material shown.

#### 16. Parts market

Non-commercial participants are allowed to sell ZÜNDAPP replacement parts, literature or tools in designated areas with a maximum size of 2 square metres (for example, a beer table of 2,20 m x 0,50 m = 1,1 square metres) without incurring any cost. It is not allowed to sell drinks, food, branded merchandise or clothing.

#### 17. Models show

On the event grounds a presentation will take place of all ZÜNDAPP vehicle models and all other ZÜNDAPP products under the sun. All participants can partake in this presentation. Inclusion of vehicles in the field reserved for specific themes should be agreed with the organiser or those working for them. In a second field vehicles can be included at will in a so called 'free line up'. Due to restrictions in space the organiser cannot guarantee the participation of vehicles in this activity.

#### 18. Beauty parade (concours d'elegance)

The most beautiful ZÜNDAPPs will be elected in various categories. Eligible are any vehicles that are shown in both the organised and the free line up fields. Any participants and those on day-visits can vote using ballots handed out during the event. There are no pre-defined criteria for the parade, instead, anyone eligible to vote can apply their own standards.

#### 19. Vehicle parade

A parade of ZÜNDAPP vehicles at low speed intends to show the variety of models across the years in motion and at the same time offer participants a group driving experience. This requires special driving discipline from each participant. The following points should be observed:

- All participants should comply with road rules and regulations
- The speed will be indicated by the leading vehicles
- Lead vehicles should not be overtaken
- Participants should keep a safe distance from other vehicles and vehicles in front
- Vehicles should stay in lane
- The position in the parade should be maintained, dropping back and overtaking is not permitted
- Stopping for reasons other than technical failure, for example to take photographs, is not permitted
- Vehicles should not deviate from the route
- In case of a technical problem, sweep up vehicles should be flagged and the vehicle should be parked immediately to the right side of the road
- Participants must follow instructions from authorities and organisers

As a result of potential limitations in time, space etc., participation in the parade cannot be guaranteed.

#### 20. Reporting to the media

All participants irrevocably agree to the use of any video, audio and other recordings in connection with the event in current and future media types by the organiser, those representing the organiser and media partners for use in photos, news feeds, broadcasts, recordings, promotional materials, etc. without requiring compensation.

#### 21. Data processing

The organiser may use information and data provided in the event entry form for purposes related to the preparation and running of the event. This includes the electronic storage and processing of this data.

### 22. Liability disclaimer

Drivers, passengers, accompanying persons and vehicle owners declare through filling out the entry form that they waive any liability or damage claims in relation to the event with the exception of wilful damage or gross negligence. This disclaimer applies to:

- The Zoller-Hof brewery, the ZÜNDAPP museum Sigmaringen and their managing directors and employees
- The partners and media partners to the event as well as sponsors, their managing directors, members of the board, presidents, members and employees.
- Local authorities, service providers, private individuals and legal entities related to preparation and running of the event.
- Damage caused by construction vehicles or condition of the roads and other materials used in relation to the event.
- Other participants, their supporters as well as the owners of all other vehicles.
- Any agents, representatives and legal representatives of the abovementioned categories.

The liability disclaimer comes into effect when the entry form is received by the organiser or when participants partake in the event.

Where participants do not own the vehicles they wish to enter into the event, they must ensure the owner of the vehicle signs the entry form including the liability clause.

If, despite the participant's obligation, the vehicle owner does not sign the entry form, the participant will release all persons and entities in article 22 from any liability claims of the vehicle owner, except in the case of wilful damage or gross negligence.

### 23. Responsibilities of the participant

Participants partake in the event at their own risk. They bear the civil and criminal liability for any damage caused by them or their vehicles.

### 24. Insurance

The organiser will take out mandatory liability insurance. For all vehicles that take part in the event, a separate liability insurance needs to be taken out by the vehicle owner (with the exception of display models that are not ridden).

### 25. Environmental Protection

Participants must avoid polluting the environment. Care must be taken to ensure that the soil of the event grounds is not contaminated with oil, grease, gasoline or other liquids. Participants are held to provide the necessary materials to prevent damage to the environment, like protecting the soil from leakage. Any damage or

contamination that is not removed will be charged to the polluter. Where parts of vehicles need to be exchanged, participants must take old parts with them.

In addition, pollution caused by oil leakage during driving or parking is to be minimised or removed. Participants are to bring the necessary tools and means for this themselves.

### 26. Advertising

Advertising of any kind is reserved for premium and promotional partners of the event and should be agreed in writing.

In general, any advertising is prohibited and especially for ZÜNDAPP related products and events without explicit consent from the organisers.

### 27. General terms

During the event and on the event grounds participants must heed instructions of the organiser or from those acting on their behalf as well as instructions from local authorities.

Open fire is prohibited on the event grounds. The use of traditional charcoal and gas grills is permitted in the area designated for tents and parking only.

However, the use of fire accelerants is prohibited and the participant must have protective measures like a fire blanket or fire extinguisher available.

The wearing of army uniforms or clothing, especially for those participants bringing army vehicles, is expressly forbidden as well as bringing or attaching fire arms.

The organiser wishes to point out § 86 of StGB (the German law book of criminal law) that forbids the wearing of unconstitutional or forbidden signs or insignia. This applies in particular to army vehicles brought by participants.

The organiser reserves the right to cancel the event or to change the content of the event should circumstances give rise. This includes force majeure, security reasons, or by order of local authorities. Cancellation or change of the event will not entitle participants to any return of funds or entry fees.

This document is a non-binding translation of the German original version. So please note that in case of a dispute only the official German version for the announcement ZÜNDAPP 100 is legally binding.
